

**50 Wynndale Drive NG5 1GZ**

Modern family garden, recently redesigned using some of the existing materials on site. The garden is on several levels - lower level is accessible but upper levels have steps to access. Artist tbc. Ice creams. Stall - prints and cards.

**34 Wimbledon Rd NG5 1GU**

Sunken garden accessed by 3 steps, featuring a low maintenance garden dealing with poor soil and a north facing aspect. Featuring a Japanese influenced area. Mosaic Artist - Sophie Robbins. Stalls - recycled jewellery, garden accessories and others.

**101 Wimbledon Rd NG5 1GX**

Small, old fashioned south facing, cottage style garden with shrubs, roses, flowerbeds, lots of pots and 6 steps down to lawn. Garage has been demolished and space used as extra terrace. Still a work in progress. Artist - Geraldine Henegan Barr (Sculptor)

**103 Wimbledon Rd NG5 1GX**

Medium-sized garden, one large border and various raised beds: work in progress, gardened by novice gardeners with parental support!

**104 Wimbledon Rd NG5 1GW**

A family friendly garden making as much use of the available space to entertain 3 children who love being outdoors. The two main features are the large outdoor dining area with a vertical garden and the custom-built pirate ship! Crafts: Three Little Pickles.

**106 Wimbledon Road NG5 1GW**

Mediterranean themed flower garden with one raised border and two other large borders. Pet friendly - 1 dog and 2 cats - so planting not always as planned! Lawn with patio and stones throughout. It's not posh but always has colour.

**87 Victoria Road NG5 2NL**

A garden of two parts: the original garden consists of lawn, mature shrubs, perennials and a pond. The garden has been extended and is a square-foot kitchen garden with art and bantams. Games and animal trail for young children. Wormery information.

**12 Rufford Rd NG5 2NR**

'QUIET' contemplative, mature, organic, quirky, cottage garden with pond and summerhouse. Access via 3 steps with handrail. Some flat access with views. Enjoy in silence only; absorbing peace/sounds from differing views. Plenty of seats. Tea and cake. Artist: The Envelope Project

**Hardwick House 4 Hardwick Road, NG5 2GW**

Enclosed, walled garden accessed via 2 steps. Partly set to lawn with a variety of plants, shrubs, small trees and herb garden, a small pond and a WW2 air raid shelter. Artist tbc. Stall - second-hand books

**Newstead Cottage 4 Newstead St, NG5 2GY**

This organic, cottage garden was created from a car park in the 2000's. It is south facing, easily accessible, located in the centre of Sherwood and has several interesting features. An artist will be painting in the garden. Refreshments - cold drinks

**13 Cannon Street NG5 2HB**

The front garden has a custom-built green-roofed shed with planters, pots and hanging baskets. The back garden is a small west-facing courtyard walled garden containing a pond planted with lilies and irises, an arbour with wisteria, clematis and jasmine, acers and a greenhouse. The Sherwood knitting circle (Sherwood Art Week yarn bombers) will be in garden. Refreshments - homemade cakes

**21 Trevoze Gardens NG5 3FU**

Access through side shed where door frames are 5ft 6' high. A mature garden being revitalised using permaculture principles. Experimental composting methods. Lawn, borders, and pergola where wisteria should be in flower. Plenty of seats. Willow structures and mosaics. Artist - Chris Baxter's baskets.

**30 Elmswood Gardens NG5 4AW**

An organic, environmentally-friendly garden interweaving fruit, vegetables and ornamentals. There's a pond and seating areas. This is a 'busy' garden, managed to include a variety of self-seeded shrubs, vegetables and flowers.

**31 Cavendish Vale NG5 4DS**

A small town garden accessed through the house or through the back gate. A continually evolving space which has seen children play, landscaping experiments and cocktail parties but always with plants as the most important guests. Artist - Alan Wilson (photographer). Jeannie Clark paintings. Stalls - homegrown produce.

**29 Drayton Street NG5 2JR**

The garden is accessed via Drayton Street. The garden has 2 raised beds, a summer house, wood store, and an assortment of plants in pots used to create a green space. An example of gardening in small spaces in an urban environment. Artist - Jeannie Clark. Refreshments - soft drinks.

**47 Devonshire Road NG5 2EW**

Steps up to an evergreen foliage garden with palms, bamboos and eucalyptus lead to a gravel garden with architectural planting. My garden leads onto the heritage listed Bagthorpe Allotment Gardens. There is a summerhouse and seating areas with views over Sherwood rooftops. Artist - Sarah Sewell, crafter and Wildgoose Designs. Plant stall.

**49 Devonshire Road NG5 2EW**

Steps at front to large garden/allotment at rear of property with chicken run and bee hives. Designed to attract and sustain wildlife with cottage garden borders, vegetable plots and diversity of habitats including large pond, trees, shrubs, and wildflowers. Musician - Karen Becky. Sculptor Michelle Reader. Stall: Bagthorpe Allotments

**50 Warren Ave NG5 1DE**

Sunny terraced garden with curving brick beds full of organically-grown and wildlife friendly plants, native and exotic. Made from reclaimed and natural materials, interesting outbuildings, ponds, crinkle-crankle walls - an eclectic mix of Gaudi meets Goldsworthy. Artists - Kind Art - mixed media art using recycled materials. Gordon Cochrane - portraitist. Plant stall.

**63 Teesdale Road NG5 1DA**

Small organic allotment garden with raised beds. There is an original 1940's underground air raid shelter that visitors are welcome to explore. Also the Alys Power Design Studio, a professional jewellers workshop, will also be open. Artist - Alys Power jewellery

**Other Spaces**

**OS1 Triangle, Burlington & Hartington Road**

The Triangle was a green, lumpy and unloved space. The Burlington and Hartington Residents Association took it over from the Council and over time have developed it into a colourful and admired community garden with shrubs, bulbs, annuals and perennials.

**OS2 Edingley Square Community Garden Edingley Square NG5 3DU**

Hidden between houses 11 and 12, accessed through pathway and gate. There are eight small vegetable plots for individual gardeners, fruit trees, fruit bushes, shared beds, spaces for wildlife, a small pond and new willow beds. Run by Transition Sherwood.

**OS3 Sherwood Methodist Church 4 Devon Drive, NG5 2EN (garden entrance on Mansfield Road)**

Craft activities in the Quiet Garden 2 - 4 PM. Refreshments

**OS4 Little Holly Corner 1 Staunton Drive NG5 3DF**

Nottinghamshire Wildlife Trust's smallest nature reserve. Open access at all times, a lovely place to sit and enjoy wildflowers, birds, butterflies and insects. There are fruit trees, nest boxes, a small pond and bug hotel. A great space for wildlife in the middle of Sherwood.

**OS5 Transition Sherwood Community Centre Garden Behind Sherwood Community Centre, Woodthorpe House, Mansfield Road, NG5 3FN**

Community garden with an emphasis on growing food, aiming for the feel of a garden rather than allotments. Flat access over grass, with uneven surfaces and parts can be muddy if wet. Entrance via gate on north side of Sherwood Community Centre building. Refreshments - herb teas
